1. Introduction

Only small fraction of our population has the privilege of getting formal higher education. Young people belonging to economically weaker sections of the society are often compelled to take up jobs to support their families before completing their formal education. With a view to providing educational opportunities to such deprived students without institutional enrolment for regular study, the Sambalpur University decided to conduct separate examinations for private candidates. The examinations are scheduled in Sundays so that the candidates can take the examinations without disrupting their normal work-schedule and without taking leave from their jobs. This being a time bound programme, the inherent functional delay infecting our system can be avoided. The present system is also designed in such a way that, barring a few stray and exceptional cases, the candidates need not come to the University office at all, and all services are provided at their door steps. Above all, the programme is also expected to contribute towards development and augmentation of human resources.

The Information Brochure presents an overview of the procedure of admission to Examinations of different Post Graduate and Under Graduate courses offered by the Private Examination Cell of Sambalpur University.

The candidates are advised to read the prospectus carefully and fill up online application form and upload required documents/materials and submit a printout (hard copy) of the application form to the Director, Private Examination Cell, Sambalpur University, Jyoti Vihar – 768019, Sambalpur, Odisha. The authority of the University will neither be responsible for any postal delay nor entertain any query in this regard. **Fees once deposited will not be refundable.**

7. How to Apply for Online Admission

The Application form, Information Brochure and other details will be available on the web from Dt. 15. 8.2021. The last date of submission of application online is Dt. 15.9.2021 and the last date of submission of hardcopy of application is Dt. 22.9.2021.

Candidates desirous of seeking admission to Examinations of different Post Graduate and Under Graduate courses are required to submit applications online by adopting the following procedure:

- **B.** The candidates should download the Information Brochure for Private Examination 2021-22 and read it carefully before filling up of form online.
- C. The candidate should deposit required amount of course fees (as mentioned in the information brochure) through State Bank Collect at the time of registration for online admission.

- **D.** The candidate should then register himself/ herself (through appropriate link) by providing the following information:
 - (a) Name of the course
 - (b) Name of the candidate
 - (c) e-mail ID
 - (d) SB Collect Reference No. (provided by the Bank)
 - (e) SBI Branch Name
 - (f) Password (to be created by the candidate) The information as above are vital and the candidate should carefully note down those for future use.
- **E.** The candidates can then fill up the form online. After completion of all the fields in the form, the candidates should click the "submit" button. There after a page will be opened with all the information of the candidate that he/she has filled in. The candidate then has to take a printout of this page and sends/submits it to The Director, Private Examination Cell, Sambalpur University, Jyoti Vihar 768019, Sambalpur, Odisha along with the following documents latest by **22.9.2021.**
- (a) Two recent passport size colour photographs of the candidate duly signed.
- (b) One set of photocopies of Mark Sheet/Certificates starting from H.S.C. to last qualifying examination self attested by the candidate.
- (c) Migration Certificate in original for candidate from other University.
- (c) University copy of Bank Challan/ e-receipt of required amount in original towards payment of processing fee.
- (d) An attested copy of the Caste Certificate obtained from a Revenue Officer not below the rank of a Deputy Collector or MLA or MP or DWO, in absence of which the candidate will not be eligible to get concession allowed under reserved categories.
- (e) Application incomplete in any manner shall be rejected

Candidates have to visit once to the Private Examination Cell, Sambalpur University on any working day within one month of online admission for First Semester Examination with original HSC certificate, qualifying certificate and Caste Certificate for verification of the date of birth and eligibility for the course. The office staff members shall verify the certificates on the same day.

Or

Candidates have to send HSC Certificate in original, Certificate of the qualifying examination and Caste Certificate along with the hard copy of online application form to the Director, Private Examination Cell by post within one month of online admission for First Semester Examination. After verification of the date of birth and eligibility for the course, all original certificates would be returned in due course.

8. Procedure for downloading the Admit Card for Examination

Candidates have to log in their panel with proper authentication and download the admit card. The online admit card will be issued in PDF format only before 15 days of the scheduled examinations.

9. Submission of Home Assignments and Commencement of Examinations

The Home Assignments allotted to students will be uploaded in the website within one month of the Semester Admission. Home Assignment carries 20 marks in each paper. Students shall submit the Home Assignments at their respective Examination Centres allotted to them within **two months** of Semester Admission. Submission of Home Assignments beyond due date will not be considered for evaluation.

The Semester Examinations will be conducted only on **Sundays.** Each Semester Examinations will be completed within 6 months of the admission.

10. Publication of Results

The results of Private Examination will be published ordinarily within 45 days from the last date of examination. The result of the examinations will be notified and published in the University website. Mark sheet will be dispatched to individual candidate within 15 days of publication of result.

11. Provision for Back Paper and Improvement of Examinations

Candidate who appears UG/PG examination under Private Examination Cell, Sambalpur University and unable to clear all papers, there is provision that he/she shall be allowed to appear back paper examination and need to clear within 5 years of first registration to the programme. However, the candidate has to pay Rs. 1500/- towards charges for back paper examination of one Semester.

A candidate who has passed UG/PG examination shall be permitted to re-appear the same examination to improve his/her performance. The candidate will be allowed to improve his/her performance in 4 papers only out of the whole syllabus. The candidate can improve in 4 papers in one chance or in more than one chance. A candidate shall not be allowed to appear for improvement in the same paper for more than once. The higher marks secured by

the candidate in each paper taken separately shall be retained for the purpose of computing his/her results.

12. Interpretation

For any dispute in interpretation in respect of the provisions of this Prospectus, the decision of the University shall be treated as final.

13. Other Relevant Rules for Private Examination

- 1. The examination hall shall be opened to the candidates half an hour before the commencement of examination
- 2. Candidates are required to take their respective seats at least 15 minutes before the commencement of examination as per the seat chart notified by the Centre Superintendent.
- 3. Attendance will be taken by the invigilators on the prescribed attendance roll sheet with full signature of the candidates against the Roll Number during the examination.
- 4. Candidates suffering from the ailments which render their presence in the examination hall undesirable in the interest of the other candidate, will not ordinarily be allowed to enter the examination hall. Candidates shall not be allowed substitute writer, except for blind, with prior approval of the University.
